

Legal scholars come together

British High Commissioner Tim Stew hosted a reception to mark the closing of the EU-Caricom Law Conference on September 27. The event which was co-hosted by German Ambassador, Holger Michael was held at the official residence of the British High Commissioner, 15 Beaumont Road, Maraval.

The conference was jointly organised by the Faculty of Law, UWI St Augustine, Brunswick European Law School (BELS) of Ostfalia University, Germany and Coventry Law School, UK. The objective of the conference was to examine the trade and development partnership between the EU, Caricom countries and regional entities. The conference also examined the role of legal partnerships in enhancing trade, investment and sustainable development.

The British High Commissioner expressed joy over the success of the conference and the partnership between UWI, Coventry Law School and the Brunswick Euro-
