Project management: Prof. Dr. Brombach, Gerndt, Lajmi, D. Meyer und Liu-Henke

Summary: The doctoral programme pursues the question of how the technological production processes relate to gender production processes. It examines how human-machine configurations arise which uphold inequality and injustice, and aims to make proposals for change. At the same time, the category of gender will be focussed on as it opens up differences by way of an example. The special feature of the doctoral programme is that this issue is to be researched on the basis of concrete case studies created as a result of transdisciplinary dialogue, and on the basis of development projects. Technological and science projects are to be integrated into a social-science and humanities discourse, and vice versa.
