

Patient Science Mucoviscidosis

Summary: The aim of the joint project is on the one hand to research – through the planning, implementation and evaluation of a patient-science study – a major problem in the everyday life of patients with cystic fibrosis and their relatives, and thus to provide a solution and, on the other hand, to exemplify the potential and limitations of patient science as a specific civic-scientific format. The project thus has one objective focussed on the particular needs of those affected by what is a rare disease (and is thus a socially relevant (first) objective), and a (second) objective addressing the methodological development and further dissemination of citizen science.

Sub-project – Healthcare research: One focal point of Ostfalia's work is expert support in the area of healthcare research for cystic fibrosis, for the entire duration of the project.
