

Mucoviscidosis: Psycho-social healthcare situation

Project management: Prof. Dr. Daniela Eidt-Koch

Summary: One aim of this research project is to survey the psycho-social healthcare situation from the point of view of the patient, as well as their needs and expectations in terms of support services. Furthermore, the current psycho-social care situation is to be analysed, and optimised psycho-social care structures are to be developed where possible. To this end, appropriate evaluation instruments for surveying patients and CF care facilities will first be developed, building on previous findings and discussions with patients, doctors and healthcare providers, as well as representatives of Patientenorganisation Mukoviszidose e.V. [Cystic Fibrosis Patients' Organisation]. Following a pre-test, a survey of patients and healthcare facilities is envisaged, in order to be able to map the social aspects of the patients and the current situation in terms of psycho-social care. After the analysis and discussion of the results, the aim is to develop an optimised psycho-social care concept. Funding: Mucoviscidosis Institute, Bonn
