

Lifelong learning at universities: a training programme for non-traditional students

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Summary: The aim of this project is to develop and trial a training

programme for non-traditional target groups at the Faculty of Public Health Services. The training programme is intended to strengthen and promote the potential of the non-traditional target group. In addition, it is to be made possible for the target group to acquire key skills, and in particular personal skills, so as to dismantle barriers to higher education and to

promote the success in the latter.
